In 2002 when he was coming back from Russia after labour migration he was taken as a hostage by a criminal group. Being in a difficult situation without money he had to cross Uzbek-Tajik border at night. Suddenly he stepped on a landmine which resulted in a serious injury.

In accordance with the Medical-Labour Expertise Panel's decision he is given 2nd group of disability with a pension of 20 Somoni per month.

At present he earns money as a daily labourer.

He wishes to buy musical instruments and play on weddings and other events.
