

# MINE ACTION - 2006 - RESULTS

1. Government compliance with implementation & reporting requirements of Ottawa Treaty. – 2 meetings attended. One National Mine Action Strategy written.
2. TMAC and the national mine action programme have competent, trained national management – 5 people trained.
3. Double cost effectiveness and productivity of mine clearance achieved in 2005. Clear at least 200,000 square metres, at less than \$12.50 per metre
4. Reduce impact of landmines on poor communities. Increase MRE and VA activities. Long-term aim is zero casualties. In 2006 we will provide financial, medical and social assistance to 90% of landmine survivors and education to all affected communities.
5. Mobilize donor commitment to the national mine action program to assure at least \$10,000,000 over the next five years, by gaining support for Tajikistan in the UNDP Completion Initiative.
