In 2002, when he was grazing livestock he stepped on a landmine. The result of this accident was that his left leg below the knee was amputated.

In accordance with the Medical-Labour Expertise Panel's decision he is given 2nd group of disability with pension 16 Somoni per month.

He lives with his aged parents, together with his entire family– 19 persons (12 children).

His dream: To have a small honey–producing business so that he can help to support his family.
